# 2022 saw a major programming return following two years of reduced offerings because of COVID restrictions.

In 2022, the Syracuse-Turkey Creek Public Library offered 394 programs for different ages, an almost 65% programming increase from 2021. These programs appealed to diverse interests and fell in line with the library's goal of promoting lifelong learning. Beyond programming, the library continued to serve the community with a variety of services and materials.


